Who Must File

Whether or not you have to file a tax return depends on your filing status and gross income.

Full-year residents of Arkansas must file a tax return if:

- Single, and gross income was at least \$10,507, or
- Head of household, and gross income was at least \$14,936, or
- Married filing a joint return, one or no dependents, and gross income was at least \$17,717, or
- Married filing a joint return, two or more dependents, and gross income was at least \$21,322, or
- Married filing separately, same or different returns, and gross income was at least \$3,999, or
- Qualifying widow or widower with a dependent child and gross income was at least \$14,936.

Non-residents or part-year residents who received income from Arkansas sources must file an Arkansas Form AR1000NR regardless of the amount of income received.
